HISTORY OF OUR BULBS

Col. Theodore Atkinson was given the land known as Atkinson by his uncle, Governor Wentworth. The Colonel was a commander of some renown during the French and Indian wars and served as collector of customs at Portsmouth. In 1748 he was appointed Secretary of the New Hampshire Colony.

Polly Peabody, daughter of Parson Stephen Peabody (one of the three founders of Atkinson Academy) entered that institution as a student. Her admission gave the Academy the right to claim the distinction as being the second co-educational academy in the country.

Ruth Sawyer was Atkinson's Town Clerk from 1942 to 1969 and conducted town business on her dining room table with a portable typewriter. Her twin brother was Valedictorian of his Dartmouth College class in 1915 and Ruth was his equal in intelligence and hard work ethic. She was also Treasurer for the town from 1944 to 1967 and a founding member of the Atkinson Historical Society.

George Parsons Dow is the only Atkinson resident to receive the Congressional Medal of Honor which was awarded for his meritorious service in the Civil War. After the Civil War, Dow also served Atkinson as Postmaster and as Trustee and Treasurer of the Kimball Library.

Louise Barnum, a founding member of our Historical Society, compiled the written record of our history in the book "Atkinson Then and Now"

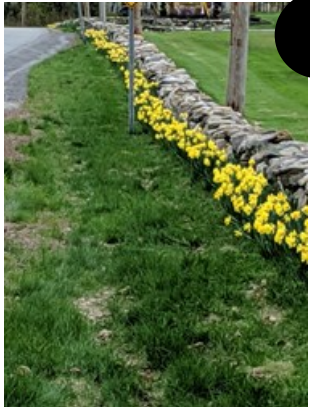
We have never needed them more! And they did not let us down. Cold winds and several snowstorms did not faze them at all. In fact, they seemed to thrive on the adversity of this spring.

Please help the Atkinson Garden Club continue this project for our community.

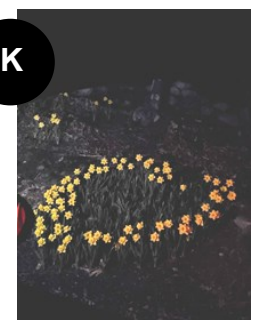
